Name:	New Zealand Cabbage Tree
Full Name:	Cordyline australis 'Burgundy Spire' PBR
Flower:	White on mature plants during summer
Leaf:	Rich, burgundy leaves from the base to the top
Mature Size:	3.0m H x 1.0m S/Trunk forming
Preferred Location:	Garden border/Patio container
Likes:	Full sun or partial shade/Most soil conditions
Dislikes:	Water logged soil and temperatures below -7°C
Grown in:	Ireland

Cordyline australis 'Bugundy Spire' is a trunk forming Cordyline with rich burgundy, very broad leaves. The basal leaves are retained for a long period of time so this variety is not getting bare at the base too quickly making it an ideal plant for your patio container. It can of course also be used in the background of your garden border. Cordyline australis 'Burgundy Spire' is a vigorous grower and easy to cultivate.
