- Spiky green leaves
- Retains basal leaves

- Trunk forming

<b>Mature Size:</b>	<b>1.2m H x 0.4m S/Trunk forming</b>

<b>Likes:</b>	<b>Full sun and free draining soil in a sheltered location</b>

Cordyline australis 'Karo Kiri' with its short spiky green leaves from the top to the bottom of the trunk is a most unusual looking variety of New Zealand Cabbage Tree. The architectural appearance of this extraordinary plant is ideally suited for your patio container or conservatory. It is hardy and likes to grow in a sunny, but sheltered position. Now you can have a fully mature Cabbage Tree on your balcony or patio.
