Name: New Zealand Cabbage Tree

Full Name: Cordyline australis 'Red Comet'

Flower: White on mature plants during summer

Leaf: Linear dusky red leaves, striking feature

Mature Size: 2.5m H x 1.0m S/Trunk forming

Preferred Location: Patio container/Garden border

Likes: Full sun and free draining soil in a sheltered location

Dislikes: Water logged soil and temperatures below -8°C

Grown in: Ireland

Cordyline australis 'Red Comet' with its palm like leaves makes a fantastic feature plant in the garden or on the patio. It is hardy and likes to grow in a sunny, but sheltered position. Its upright growing habit makes it an ideal plant to use alongside sedges or other high contrast foliage and flowering plants. 'Red Comet' is a more suitable selection of Cordyline for use in open garden positions.
