Phormium cookianum 'Black Adder', discovered in Ireland at FitzGerald Nurseries is a very striking and adaptable plant in large containers or in the garden. 'Black Adder' will grow happily even on exposed sites and coastal areas without losing its appeal. It is also tolerant of many soil types from heavy to light sandy. The clump forming growth habit with pendulous tipped leaves makes Phormium cookianum 'Black Adder' an ideal feature plant for the garden or patio position.
